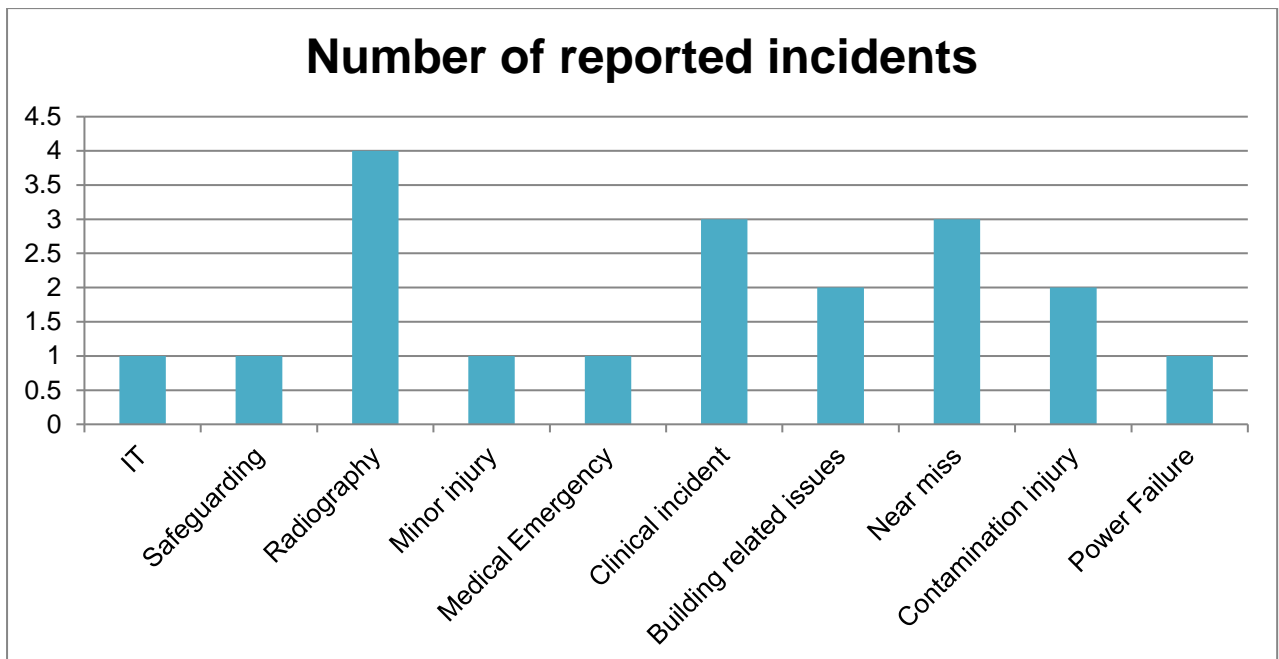

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Total Incidents

Full breakdown by incident type as follows:

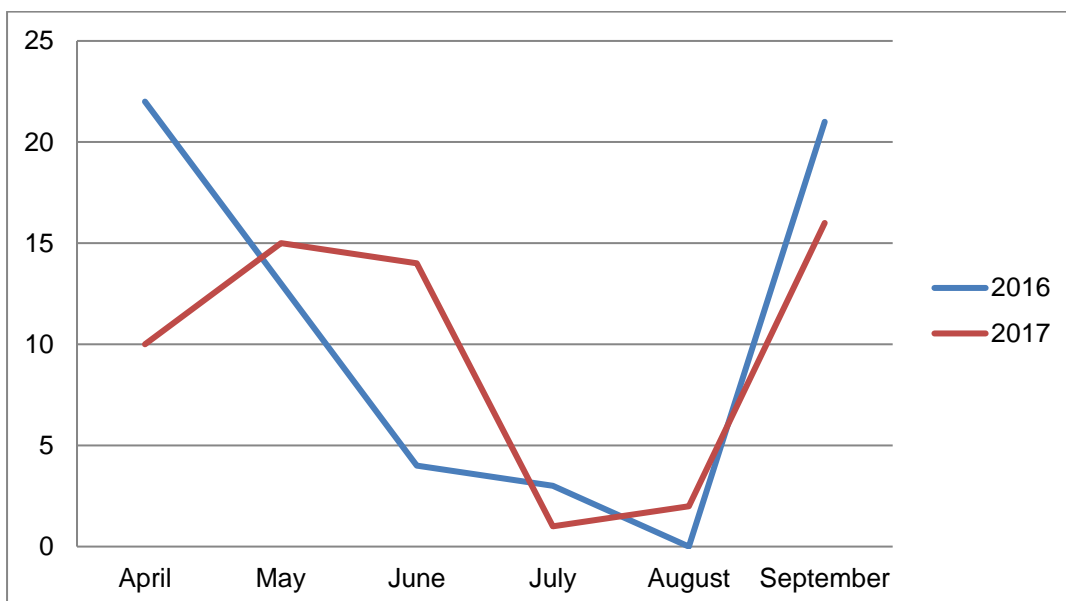


There were a total of 19 reported incidents in Quarter 2. This shows a decrease from 39 in Q1, which will be due in part to the level of clinical activity and non-term time in these months. It also shows a decrease from the same quarter last year (24).

Radiography showed the highest frequency with 4 incidents reported. Radiography incidents recorded were mainly repeat exposure due to hardware/software issues.

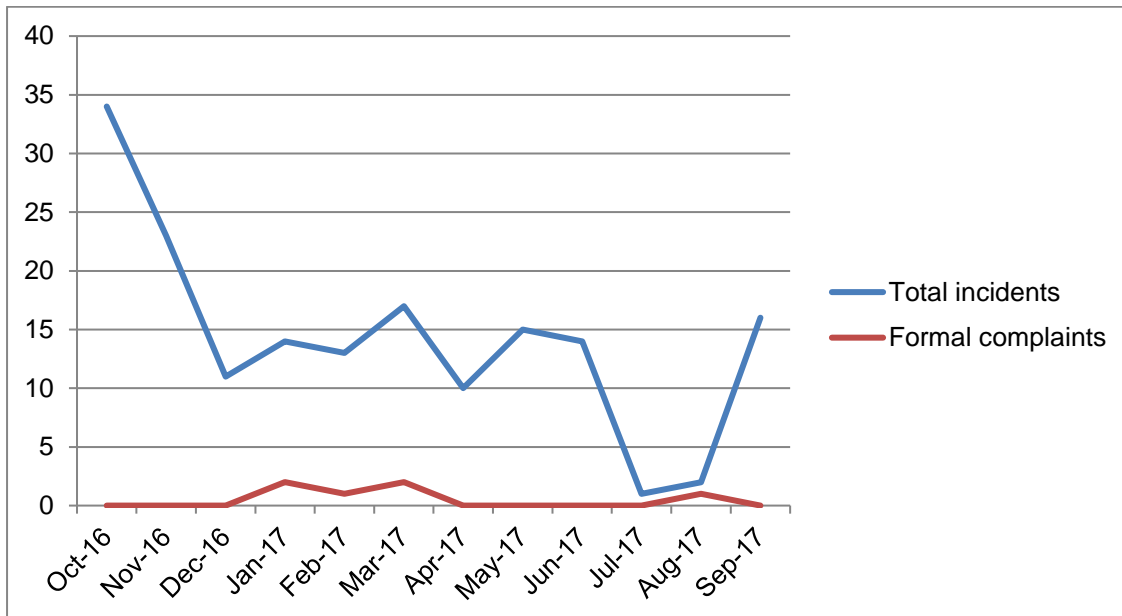

Q on Q there has been a slight decrease in the number of incidents overall. In September incidents spike as a result of students returning and associated increase in clinical activity.

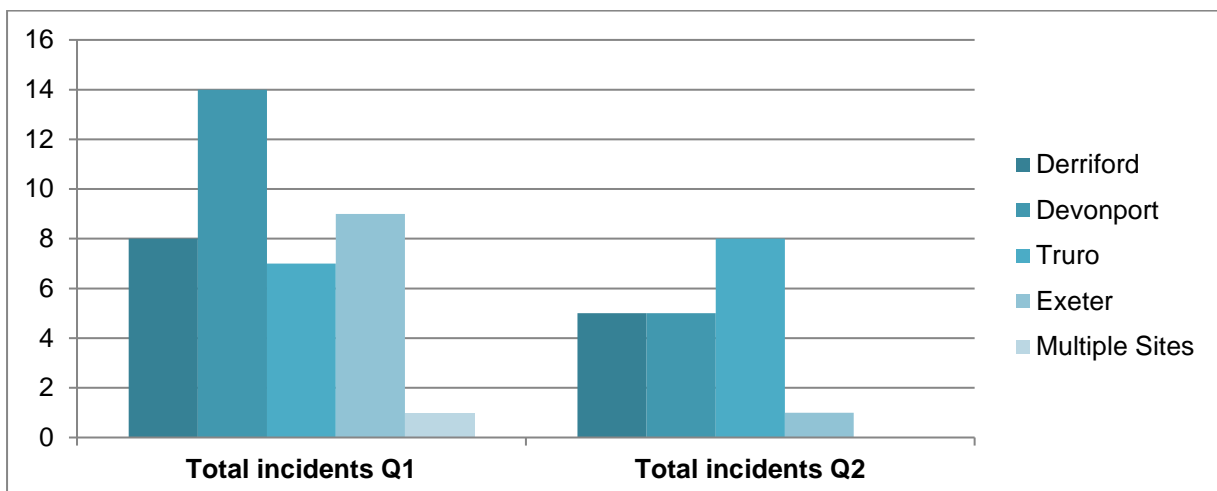
Total Incidents and Formal Complaints for the Calendar Year

There was one formal complaint received in Q2, however this was regarding concerns over a contractor driving whilst off site.

Breakdown of Incidents by DEF in Q1/Q2 (Comparison)



Each DEF will have varying levels of clinical activity and different year groups and, as a result cannot be directly compared.

Full Breakdown of Clinical Incidents in Q2

Month	DEF	Incident Details
September	Truro	Student's implant retained crown came out whilst having impressions taken.
September	Devonport	Bioclear not fully flushed from system tinging colour of water through chair.
September	Derriford	Patients lip caught by burr during crown prep. Minor injury.

Contamination Injuries

There were 2 contamination injuries reported during Q2. The injuries were as follows:

- PDSE Dentist received inoculation injury to elbow from Cavitron scaler used on patient.
- Student identified scratch on wrist after clinic however not reported until 24 hours after incident.

Medical Emergencies

There was one medical emergency in Q2, in September. A patient fell ill during treatment and had a seizure. This was a result of a pre-existing medical condition and reaction to LA. Incident was dealt with well by all staff and students.

Incorrect irreversible treatment

There were no incorrect irreversible treatment incidents in Q2.
