## **Denture care – Permanent soft linings**

## Care of permanent soft linings - Patient Information Card

A soft denture liner has been applied to the inner surface of your denture. This acts as a cushion between the soft tissue of your mouth and the hard plastic denture base.

## Please observe the following cleaning instructions:

- Rinse the denture thoroughly after every meal and remove debris by brushing gently with a soft brush, soap and cold water.
- This is best carried out over a basin of water so that, if you accidently drop the denture, it will not break.
- Use an appropriate denture cleaner specific to the lining used and ask your dentist to advise.
- Then rinse the denture thoroughly with cold water and soak in water overnight.
- Tartar and other substances may form deposits on your denture. These should be removed by your dentist.
- Soft linings normally last about 18 months, before they significantly deteriorate.
